Our Christmas Concert will take place on Thursday, 14th December, in Coagh Presbyterian Church Hall, performances beginning at 10 am and 7 pm. All children will go home at 12 noon following the morning performance (There will be 'Fun Club' and 'Homework Club'). Pupils should return to school at 6.30 pm for the evening performance. Children should wear school uniform for both performances and they will change into costumes in school prior to their performances.

Parents not attending the evening performance should collect their children from their classroom at approx. 8.30 pm. Following their late night, children can come into school on Friday, 15th December, any time up to 10.30 am. School will open as 'usual' from 8:30 am.

Like last year, we have decided not to allocate 'tickets' for the performances because, based on the survey results from last year, there would be enough seats for those wishing to attend. We would encourage those family members who are able to attend the 10 am performance to please do so as this would 'free up' seats for the 7 pm performance for those unable to attend the morning performance due to work commitments, etc. Based on previous experience, the 7 pm performance is much busier so we would encourage you, if possible, to restrict the members of your family attending to 2 or 3. We have seating for approx. 180 people on Thursday evening and if two people attend from each of our families that accounts for 166 seats with a few extras.

Charity Donation

The School Council decided that the money raised from this year's Charity Donation would go to two organisations - 'Helping Hand,' which is the Charity to the Royal Belfast Hospital for Sick Children, and to further the work of Coagh Presbyterian Church.
