Early Bird & Fun Clubs

Once again, this year both the Early Bird Club and the Fun Club will take place in the School hall. On dry mornings, the Early Bird Club will be outside. If you are using this club, please bring your child into school and leave them with Libby Carleton, either in the hall or

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outside. All schoolbags and coats should be left in the cloakrooms. Please do not drop children off before **8.30am**.

Children who do not use the Early Bird Club should come to school **no earlier than 8.50am** for school starting at 9.00am.

Water bottles

Coagh PS water bottles are available in school at a cost of £2 each. Children can bring any water bottle to school each day, and drink when needed. However, please make sure water bottles have only water inside, not juice.

P1

We have 22 new P1's beginning in September. Please remember all P1's go home at 12 noon for the first 2 weeks in September (Until Monday 16th). However, if your child is entitled to free school meals, he/she can be collected after they have their dinner, at 12.45pm, either in the school playground or from the dining hall. On Monday 16th September all new P1 pupils will stay in school until 1pm and they will get either school dinners or packed lunches. At 1pm the P1 pupils will be collected from the front door of the school. From Monday, 30th September, P1 children will stay to 1.45pm. After that time, they can choose to either go home, or stay until 3pm at our Fun Club. Homework Club is also available to them.

Homework Club

Following the success of Homework Club during the last two years it has been agreed that Homework Club will continue during 2019/20 in the same format as last year. Homework Club will run from 3pm – 5.30pm each day with the following pricing structure- £3 per hour or £7 from 3pm – 5.30pm. Homework Club will begin on Monday 2nd September 2019 from 3pm – 5.30pm and is available for all pupils P1-P7.

School Meals

The cost of school meals remains at £2.60 per day, or £13.00 per week. Please send money in a labelled envelope.

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Snack Money

Pupils in P1 to P3 should send £3 snack money in a labelled envelope, separate from dinner money into school each Monday morning. P1 pupils should send £1.20 on 29/08/18 and P2/3 should send 60p on 30/08/18.

School Uniform

Could I remind parents to please ensure your child wears full school uniform to school each day.

Please ensure that all items of uniform have your child's name on them

Boys – polo shirt, school sweatshirt, grey trousers, grey socks, black shoes (no jogging bottoms or multicoloured trainers).

Girls – polo shirt, school sweatshirt, grey skirt/pinafore/trousers, grey tights/white socks, black shoes (no jogging bottoms or multicoloured trainers).

P1 PE

P1 children should bring the appropriate sportswear in a PE bag which should be left in school.

P2 - P7 PE Uniform

Following the success of Key Stage 2 pupils wearing 'PE Uniform' to school each Wednesday for PE last year it has been decided that this should continue during 2019/20. From the 4th September 2019 pupils from P2 – P7 should come to school on their PE day (Wednesday) wearing plain black/navy sports bottoms/leggings and trainers. These will be worn with their school Polo Shirt and Jumper. (We urge pupils to wear dark sports bottoms/leggings as they blend in with current uniform. No multi-coloured ones please, otherwise PE Uniform will need to be revised)

Free school meals

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) can apply if your son or daughter is in full-time education and if you are in receipt of one of the following benefits: -

- Income Support;
- Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance;
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance;
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit;
- Child Tax Credit or Working Tax Credit with an annual taxable income of £16,190 or less;
- Universal credit and have net household earnings not exceeding £14,000 per year.

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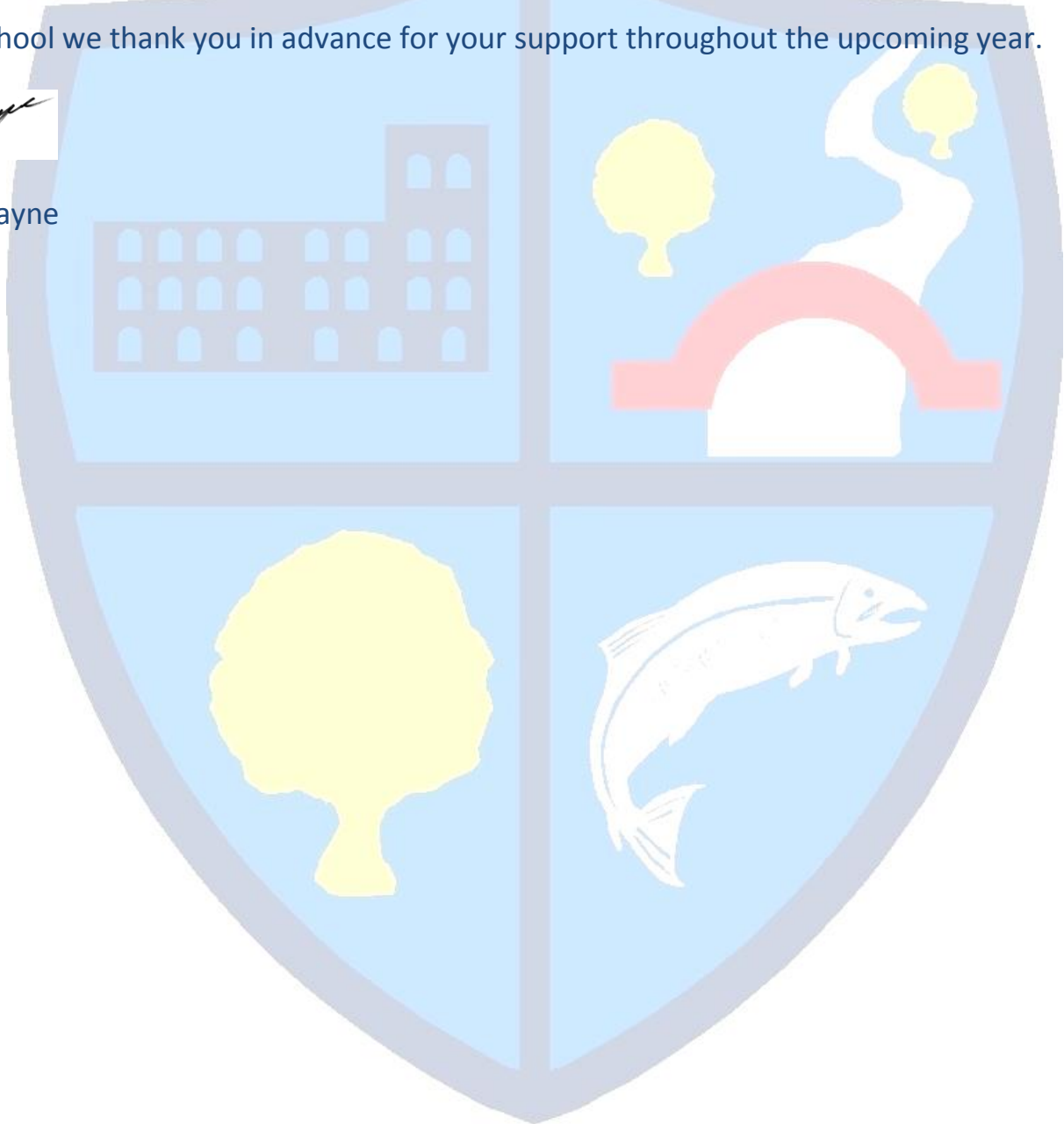
Collection of Pupils
