All squads will receive 10 'participation' medals except the winning team in each section who will receive 10 'winners' medals and the trophy.

Please Read and Observe

Normal rules of mini-soccer should be observed. Below are some local rules to assist organisation:

- Each match will last 10 minutes with no 'half time'.
- There is a 2 minute 'turn around' between matches.
- Each team should consist of 7 players. (Squad should be a max 10 pupils so that medals can be ordered) (Boys only squad is okay or a squad can be a mixture of Boys and Girls)
- Games on all three pitches will start and end at the organiser's signal. (Air Horn)
- No off-side.
- Goal-kicks can be taken from the goalkeeper's hands.
- Goalkeepers can come out of their 'goalkeeping area' and use their feet to 'clear' the football. If they handle the ball outside their 'goalkeeping area' it is a 'direct' free kick.
- No pass-back rule.
- Players from both sides are allowed inside the 'goalkeeping area'
- Parental **SUPPORT** is encouraged.
- No limit to substitutions and these are 'roll on, roll off' throughout the match.
- Throw in's will be taken from the side line when the ball goes 'out'.
- Corners/Goal Kicks will be taken when the ball goes over the line behind the goals.

<u>Teachers are responsible for the behaviour and conduct</u> <u>of both their players and their supporters. Positive</u> <u>encouragement and fair play is expected at all times.</u>

Teams and Spectators

Each school should select an area inside the enclosed pitch where they can 'base' themselves during the tournament. Players should only leave the enclosed pitch to access the toilets in the club house building beside the pitch.

Spectators i.e. parents should remain outside the enclosed pitch area away from all the teams (Child Protection and Covid Reasons). All three pitches can easily be viewed from outside the perimeter fence.

Layout of Coagh Sports Arena

Parents/buses should avoid driving and parking in the 'green' pedestrian zone between the 3G pitch and Clubhouse. This will allow pupils safe access to the toilets throughout the tournament.

Parents/Spectators are able to watch the matches through the security fencing surrounding the 3G pitch. Only footballers and teachers/coaches should be inside the security fence and on the 3G pitch.
